Our Priorities 2024/25

Current situation

On analysis of the spelling standardised test results July 2024 the percentage of children with a standardised score below the average range was 26%. Concerns regarding independence with spelling and in particular with high frequency words.

Priority 1: To ensure children are developing their spelling skills and using across the curriculum.

Our Priorities 2024/25

Current situation

Many pupils' skills in number are good or very good, however a minority 25% of pupils score below 90 in the Welsh National Mathematical tests.

Priority 2: To ensure children are developing their mathematical skills and using across the curriculum.

Current situation

Working within the cluster as part of the School Partnership Programme a review of musical skills will take place and programme of studies developed.
