Helpful Information

Welcome back! We have had a great day getting to know our new children and settling them into new routines for their first year in Key Stage 2, here at Bryn Coch. The children have had a busy first day and are already becoming more familiar with the routines and finding out where everything is. The children are very excited to get started with their first topic this year which will be The Celts/Europe.

PE

All classes have outdoor PE on a Tuesday. Please ensure your child comes to school in their P.E. kit on this day, as changing facilities are not available. If for any reason your child cannot participate in P.E. please let their class teacher know.

Homework

Homework will be given out half-termly. There will be a number of tasks for your child to choose from, with a minimum of 3 to be completed, this will need to come back into school the week before half term. We also ask that your child practices everyday maths activities such as telling the time, using money and times tables. Please ensure your child reads daily at home as this will further enhance their reading and comprehension skills. Seesaw will also be used to complete additional tasks when needed.

Maths and English Sets

Due to the current restrictions, we will not be moving classes to set for Maths or English. We will, however, be providing differentiated work.

Snack

In Key Stage Two, children are only allowed to have fruit snack at play times. This can be brought from home, or purchased in school at first play, for 30p per day. If you would like your child to have school snack please pay £1.50, in advance on a Monday in a clearly labelled envelope. If your child only wants snack from school on two days of the week, for example, the money still needs to be paid in advance on a Monday in an envelope indicating which days they are having snack.

Children will be asked only to eat fruit at play times.
