Dear Parent/Carer / Annwyl Rhieni/Gofalwyr

As you may have seen in the media if the scientific advice still says it is safe to do so then all children will continue to return to school on Monday March 15th.

The children will arrive at the usual time of 8.45 at the taxi drop off area. Social distancing needs to be strictly maintained at all times on the school premises and parents who drop off need to wear a face covering.

PLEASE NOTE NO LATES WILL BE PERMITTED.

At the end of the day the Resource children will need to be collected at 2.45pm from the taxi area doors.

Resource children will have a specific set of toilets to use and will have to remain in their class setting and group setting.

Social distancing needs to be strictly maintained at all times on the school premises. There is an 'in' lane and an 'out' lane on the main yard gate. The ramp entrance off Wrexham road will be open. We would also ask parents to approach school wearing a face covering using the left-hand pavement from the cemetery (school side) and leave school using the opposite pavement on the side of the county football pitch.

Packed Lunch will be eaten in the child's classroom. Dolce catering are offering their full menu which can be ordered on line or on the day in the classroom. These hot meals will also be served in the children's classroom. Children will be required to wear school uniform everyday other than their PE day, which for Resource is Friday. On Friday Resource children should come to school in the Bryn Coch PE kit if possible. No football kits please.
