Year 6 Summer Fayre

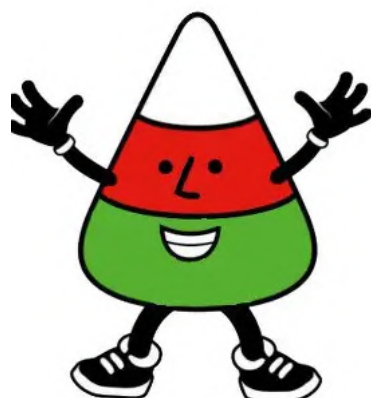
