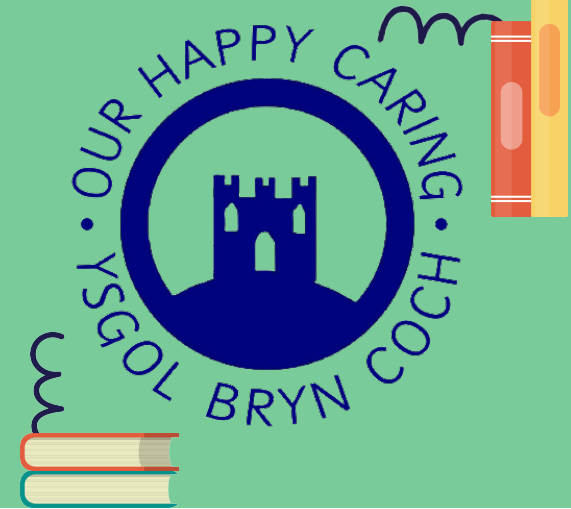
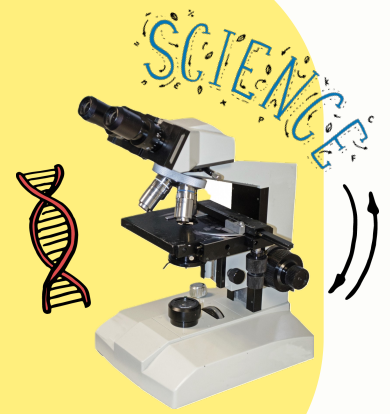


Busy, busy, busy!
